SPRY TROPHY TRIAL for Sporting Trials Cars and Solo Motor Cycles

Supplementary Regulations

1. The Launceston and North Cornwall Motor Club Ltd will organise a Clubman Permit Sporting Trial on Sunday 29th January 2017 at Trevilla Farm, Marshgate, Camelford, PL32 9YN (Map. Ref. 190/145911) by kind permission of David Langley.

2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the M.S.A. (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FISA) and the sporting code of the AMCA, these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising Club may issue for the event.

3. Permits have been applied for.

4. The event is open to all members of the Organising Club (Club Membership ± 10.00). Motorcycle Day Membership available ± 1.00 .

- 5. All competitors and drivers must produce a valid Club Membership Card.
- 6. The programme will be:-

Scrutineering starts are 10:00 am Any competitor not signed on by 10:45 am may be excluded. Starts at 11.00.

7. Public roads will not be used to link sections. There will be at least 16 sections on private land. The entry may be split into groups starting on different hills.

8. The event will consist of 5 classes as follows:-

- 1. B.T.R.D.A. Contenders Red and Blue
- 2. B.T.R.D.A. Contenders Green and non B.T.R.D.A. Contenders
- 3. Solos- Trial or Trail tyres and factory fitted lights.
- 4. Non-road registered trials motor cycles on trials tyres.
- 5. Junior motorcycle (16 years of age and under).

9. All cars must comply with MSA Technical Regulations and the permitted tyres will be as list 3 section 3. The bikes must conform with AMCA Regulations. All vehicles must have effective silencing; any vehicle considered by the scrutineer to be too noisy will not be allowed to start.

10. All cars must comply with BTRDA tyre regulations – *Permitted Tyres* Maxxis MA-510N, VredesteinT Trac 2 and Nankang ECX 668.

- 11. Awards will be presented as follows:-
- i. The Spry Trophy to the Best Car Performance overall.
- ii. A trophy for best bike overall
- ii. Class win to winner of the other classes.Other awards may be presented at organisers' discretion.

12. The entry opens on publication of regs. and closes finally and definitely on Wednesday 25^{th} January 2017. The entry fee is £18.00 (Juniors and £6 Day Membership). All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

PLEASE NOTE This trial will not run unless the minimum entries are received by 25 January.

14. The maximum entry for the meeting is 15 cars and 15 solos. The minimum is 10. The minimum for each class is 4. Should any minimum figure not be reached the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate the classes. Entry fees may be refunded if notified by 26 January.

18. Starting numbers will be decided by ballot and provided by the organisers.

- 19. Marking (a) Sections will be marked 12-1 from start line.
 - (b) MSA regulations M4 2.16 will apply to cars.
 - (c) Motor cycles will be marked depending on conditions on the day but probably 3 dabs allowed.
 - (d) All competitors marks will be lost for hitting a market or driving outside boundary of Section.
- 20. Results Provisional results on the day and copies within 14 days.

21. Directions:- From A39 6 miles east of Camelford at Otterham Café, turn north towards Marshgate, after 500 yard left into gated track. Park in lane before farm.
