Supplementary Regulations

- 1. The Launceston and North Cornwall Motor Club Ltd will organise a Clubman Sporting Trial on Saturday, June 8th, 2019 at Ashley Farm, Lifton (MR201/395842) by kind permission of Paul Webber.
- 2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports UK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA). These Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising Club may issue for the event.
- 3. Permit numbers TBA.
- 4. The event is open to fully elected members of the organising club, BTRDA, CameL Vale, 750 MC ,MTCC.All drivers must produce a valid club membership card.
- 5. The programme will be:- Scrutineering starts at 1pm, First car starts at 2pm.
- 6. Public roads will not be used to link sections. There will be at least 5 sections on private land run 4 times (weather permitting). The entry may be split into groups starting on different hills.
- 7. The event will consist of four classes as follows:-
 - 1 Red Live/Independent.
 - 2 Blue Live/Independent.
 - 3 Green Class Novice drivers as per the BTRDA listings and other drivers.
 - 4 Post Historic.
- 8. All vehicles must comply with Motor Sport UK Technical Regulations. *Tyres must comply with 2019 MSA Yearbook 12.9.3.* All vehicles must have effective silencing; any vehicle considered by the scrutineer to be too noisy will not be allowed to start. All cars in the post historic class can use tyres in accordance with T14.81 & T14.82.
- 9. Awards will be presented as follows:
 - 1. A trophy for the Best Performance overall.
 - 2. Class win to winner of the other classes. (Subject to at least 4 entrants).

Other awards may be presented at organiser's discretion.

- 10. The entry opens on publication of regs and closes finally on Thursday, June 5^{th} , 2019. The entry fee is £20. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

- 12. The maximum entry for the meeting is 40. The minimum is 8. The minimum for each class is 4. Should any minimum figure not be reached the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting

or amalgamate the classes. Entry fees may be refunded if notified by June 7th, 2019.

- 16. Starting numbers will be decided by ballot and provided by the organisers.

- 18. Results Provisional results on the day and copies within 14 days.
- 19. Directions from A30 west or east take Lifton turning at Lifton Down. Proceed on old A30 to Lifton Village (1 mile), at Lifton Hall Hotel, right into Leat Road (arrowed/marked unsuitable for HGVs). Straight on over river bridge and after old railway bridge bear left, 2nd right (by cottage) up steep narrow hill for a further 400m and right into field before junction.
- 20. Please note, strictly no unauthorised vehicles or motorcycles to be taken beyond the paddock.
