## SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS TESTING TRIAL on Sunday 21<sup>ST</sup> AUG 2022 For Cars (Non-damaging)

Launceston & North Cornwall Motor Club Ltd will organise a Testing Trial open to cars. The event will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sport UK, incorporating provisions of the sporting code of the FIA, these regulations and any others than may be issued later.

**1.** *The Event* A single venue event on private land at Trevilla Farm Marshgate Camelford Cornwall PL329YN what three words- STILTED.CURTAINS.DIGNITY and will consist of a number of observed tests. Marks will be awarded for completion of each test or section correctly as well as times taken where appropriate. There will be a number of tests and rounds dependent on time and size of entry.

Scrutineering and signing on will commence at 10.00 am. All competitors must be signed on by 10.30 am and the first competitor starts at 10.45 am with a lunch break to follow after completion of the morning rounds.

- **2. Eligibility** The event is open to all members of the Launceston & North Cornwall Motor Club Ltd and by invitation to members of Holsworthy, Camel Vale and Wind Whistle Motor Clubs. who are fully paid up members for 2022. Competitors must be prepared to show the 2022 membership cards on request.
- 3. All Drivers (and passengers aged 18 or over) are required by MotorSport UK to have a RS Clubman licence. This is free & can be obtained online from their website- Drivers &passengers under 18 will also require parental consent. T4.1.3 applies allowing younger drivers(age 14,15,16 & 17) without a RTA licence to compete but only with passenger holding a] RTA licence b] has trials driver experience & c] must have valid club membership. Otherwise competitors are not required to have a passenger if they wish not to.
- 4. Motor Sport UK Permit No. TBA
- 5. Classes Normal trial classes will not apply. Instead vehicles will fall into the following classes.
  - a. Closed Cars
  - b. Open Cars
  - c. National Trials Formula Cars.

All vehicles must comply with standard regulations covering Car Trials, but an MOT certificate will not be required

## 6. Awards

There will be separate awards for performances in each class subject to 4 starters in class. The Invitation Trophy for the best overall performance.

The best performance by a Front Wheel Drive Car.

Novice Award.

Other Class Awards will be at the organiser's discretion

Overall awards will be based on adjusted times. Class C competitors will not be eligible for an overall award.

**7. Entries** Open immediately and close finally on Wednesday 17 AUG 2022. Late entries will not be accepted. Entries must be made on the correct form (or photocopy) and should be completed with the entry fee of £22.00 (under 18 £10.00) and sent to –
