SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS INVITATION TROPHY PRODUCTION CAR AUTOTEST on Sunday 17 AUGUST 2025 (Non-damaging)

Launceston & North Cornwall Motor Club Ltd will organise a Production Car Autotest. The event will be governed by the National Competition Rules (NCR) of the Motor Sport UK, incorporating provisions of the sporting code of the FIA, these regulations and any others than may be issued later.

- 1. The Event** A single venue event on private land at Trevilla Farm, Marshgate, Camelford, Cornwall, PL329 YN (MR 190/145911) (what three words-STILTED.CURTAINS.DIGNITY) and will consist of a number of observed tests. Marks will be awarded for completion of each test correctly as well as times taken. There will be a number of tests and rounds dependent on time and size of entry.

Scrutineering and signing on will commence at 10.45 am. All competitors must be signed on by 11.15 am and the first competitor starts at 11.30 am with a lunch break to follow after completion of the morning rounds.

- 2. Eligibility** The event is open to all members of the Launceston & North Cornwall Motor Club Ltd and by invitation to members of Holsworthy, Camel Vale and Wind Whistle Motor Clubs. – who are fully paid up members for 2025. Competitors must be prepared to show the 2025 membership cards on request.
- 3. All Drivers**(and passengers aged 18 or over) are required by MotorSport UK to have a RS Clubman licence .This is free & can be obtained online from their website-

A PASSENGER MUST BE CARRIED IN ALL TIMED TESTS

Drivers & passengers under 18 will require parental consent. Ch19, App5, Art3 & 4 NCR applies allowing younger drivers (age 14, 15, 16 & 17) without a RTA licence to compete but only with passenger holding a] RTA licence b] has Autotest driver experience , c] must have valid club membership & the vehicle must be a Touring car (4 seater with fixed roof) under 2000 cc, .

The best performance by a Front Wheel Drive Car.

Other Class Awards will be at the organiser's discretion

Overall awards may be based on index adjusted times.

Points from the event will count toward Cann Medland Trophy & Members Challenge Bowl.
