## ***SEPTEMBER TRIAL for Solo Motor Cycles - Sunday 4th September 2016***

### **Supplementary Regulations**

1. The Launceston and North Cornwall Motor Club Ltd will organise a Clubman Permit Trial on Sunday 4th September at Trevilla Farm, Marshgate, Camelford, Cornwall, PL32 9YN. Map ref 190 145911. By kind permission of David Langley.
2. The meeting will be governed by the sporting code of the AMCA, these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising Club may issue for the event.
3. Permit has been applied for.
4. The event is open to all members of the Organising Club (Club Membership £10.00 to run for the rest of 2016, or Day Membership £1.00), Pendennis Motorcycle Club, Camel Vale Motor Club, Holsworthy Motor Club, and those holding an AMCA licence.
5. All competitors must produce a valid Club Membership Card, AMCA licence, or pay for day membership.
6. The programme will be:-  
  
Scrutineering starts are 10:00 am  
Any competitor not signed on by 10:45 am may be excluded.  
Starts at 11.00.
7. Public roads will not be used to link sections. There will be at least 6 sections on private land ( attempted more than once). The entry may be split into groups starting on different sections.
8. The event will consist of 2 classes as follows:-
  1. Solo Trail Motorcycles
  2. Solo Day Trial Motorcycles
9. Motorcycles must conform to AMCA Trials Rule Book. All must have effective silencing; any considered by the Scrutineer to be too noisy will not be allowed to start. Riders clothing and helmets must conform to AMCA Trials Rule Book paragraph 15
10. Awards will be presented as follows:-
  - (i) A Trophy for the Best Performance overall.
  - (ii) Class Award to winner of the other class.Other awards may be presented at organisers' discretion.
11. The entry opens on publication of regs. and closes finally and definitely on Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2016. The entry fee is £15.00. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

13. The maximum entry for the meeting is 30 solos. The minimum is 8. The minimum for each class is 3. Should any minimum figure not be reached the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate the classes. Entry fees may be refunded if notified by 1<sup>st</sup> September.

15. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with AMCA requirements

17. Starting numbers will be decided by ballot and provided by the organisers.

18. **Marking** (a) Sections will be defined with posts from start line. Machines will start with the front wheel on the line, and finish the section when the back wheel has passed the finish line.  
(b) Marking will be in accordance with paragraph 33 of the AMCA Trials Rule Book using the 0,1,2,3,5 system.  
(c) Detail of this marking system will be posted at the Start, and any other details referred to in the Briefing.

19. **Results** – Provisional results on the day and copies within 14 days.

20. **Directions:-** From A39 6 miles east of Camelford at Otterham Station, just after Café, turn north towards Marshgate. After 500 yards L into gated track to "Trevilla" Farm. Follow track to Paddock .
