SPRY TROPHY TRIAL for Solo Motor Cycles - 28 January 2018

Supplementary Regulations

1. The Launceston and North Cornwall Motor Club Ltd will organise a Clubman Permit Sporting Trial on on 28 January 2018 at Trevilla Farm, Marshgate, Camelford, PL32 9YN, - Map Ref 190/145/911 By kind permission of David Langley.

2. The meeting will be governed by the sporting code of the AMCA, these Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising Club may issue for the event.

3. Permits have been applied for.

4. The event is open to all members of the Organising Club (Club Membership £10.00) and those belonging to the AMCA. Motorcycle Day Members available £1..

5. All competitors and drivers must produce a valid Club Membership Card.

6. The programme will be:-

Scrutineering starts are 10:00 am Any competitor not signed on by 10:45 am may be excluded. Starts at 11.00.

7. Public roads will not be used to link sections. There will be at least 12 sections on private land. The entry may be split into groups starting on different hills.

8. The event will consist of 3 classes as follows:-

- 2. Trial or Trail tyres and factory fitted lights.
- 3. None road registered trials motor cycles on trials tyres.
- 4. Junior motorcycles (16 years of age and under).

9. The bikes must conform with AMCA Regulations for trials. All vehicles must have effective silencing; any vehicle considered by the scrutineer to be too noisy will not be allowed to start.

10. Awards will be presented as follows:- (i) A trophy for best bike overall.

- (ii) Class win to winner of the other classes.

Other awards may be presented at organisers' discretion.

11. The entry opens on publication of regs. and closes finally and definitely on 25 January 2018. The entry fee is £18.00 (Juniors £6 plus day ticket membership.). All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

13. The maximum entry for the meeting is 15 solos. The minimum is 8. The minimum for each class is 4. Should any minimum figure not be reached the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate the classes. Entry fees may be refunded if notified by 25 January.

15. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with Regulations.

16. Starting numbers will be decided by ballot and provided by the organisers.

- 17. Marking (a) Sections will be marked 12-1 from start line.
 - (b) Motor cycles will be marked depending on conditions on the day but probably 3 dabs allowed.
 - (c) All competitors marks will be lost for hitting a market or driving outside boundary of Section.

18. Results – Provisional results on the day and copies within 14 days.

19. Directions:- From A39 6 miles east of Camelford at Otterham Cafe turn north towards Marshgate. After 500 yards into gated track. Park in lane before farm.

PLEASE NOTE Use of motorcycles on the site is restricted to authorised competitors only.
