Supplementary Regulations

- The Launceston and North Cornwall Motor Club Ltd will organise a Clubman Sporting Trial on Sunday 10th November 2019 at Ashley Farm, Lifton (MR201/395842) by kind permission of Paul Webber
- 2. The meeting will be governed by the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association Ltd. (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA). These Supplementary Regulations and any written instructions that the organising Club may issue for the event.
- 3. Permit numbers TBA.
- 4. The event is a qualifying round of the 2019 ASWMC Sporting Trials Championship. Registration TBA.
- 5. The event is open to any registered ASWMC Sporting Trial contender and all contenders must produce a valid MS uk Competition Licence. Non-contenders must be members of the organising Club (Club Membership £10.00) or members of Camel Vale Motor Club, BTRDA or MTCC.
- 6. The programme will be:- Scrutineering starts are 10:00 am,
 Any competitor not signed on by 10:45 am may be excluded,
 First car starts at 11:05 am after customary two minute silence

for Remembrance Sunday.

- 7. Public roads will not be used to link sections. There will be at least 8 sections on private land (weather permitting). The entry may be split into groups starting on different hills.
- 8. The event will consist of six classes as follows:-
 - 1 Red Live
 - 2. Red Independent
 - 3 Blue Live/
 - 4. Blue Independent.
 - 5. Green Class Novice drivers as per the BTRDA listings and other drivers.
 - 6 Post Historic.
- 9. All vehicles must comply with MSUK Technical Regulations. Tyres must comply with 2019 MS Yearbook 12.9.3. All vehicles must have effective silencing; any vehicle considered by the scrutineer to be too noisy will not be allowed to start. All cars in the post historic class can use tyres in accordance with T14.81 & T14.82.
- 10. Awards will be presented as follows:
 - 1. The Ron Beer Trophy to the Best Performance overall.
 - 2. Class win to winner of the other classes. (Subject to at least 4 entrants).

Other awards may be presented at organiser's discretion.

11. The entry opens on publication of regs and closes finally on 8^{th} November 2019. The entry fee is £25.00. All entries must be made on the official entry form and accompanied by the appropriate fee.

- 13. The maximum entry for the meeting is 40. The minimum is 8. The minimum for each class is 4. Should any minimum figure not be reached the organisers have the right to cancel the meeting or amalgamate the classes. Entry fees may be refunded if notified by 8th November 2019.

- 16. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with 06.2.6.
- 17. Starting numbers will be decided by ballot and provided by the organisers.
- The finish will be at the venue. No refreshments available on site.
- 19. Results Provisional results on the day and copies within 14 days.
- 20. Directions from A30 west or east take Lifton turning at Lifton Down. Proceed on old A30 to Lifton Village (1 mile), at Lifton Hall Hotel, right into Leat Road (arrowed/marked unsuitable for HGVs). Straight on over river bridge and after old railway bridge bear left, 2nd right (by cottage) up steep narrow hill for a further 400m and right into field before junction.
- 21. Please note, strictly no unauthorised vehicles or motorcycles to be taken beyond the paddock.
