

## Minehead Motor Club Ltd Rollies Car Trial Sunday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2021 Supplementary Regulations

- 1. Minehead Motor Club will organise a Clubmans permit Car Trial on the 31st of October 2021 at Bratton, near Minehead, Somerset. TA24 8SR OS map reference 181/940458.
- 2. The meeting will be held under the General Regulations of the Motorsport UK Ltd (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), these supplementary regulations and any written instructions the organising club may issue for the event
- 3. The event will be run under MSA Clubman permit number 123312.
- 4. The event is open to fully elected members of the organising club, members of Woolbridge MC and Launceston & North Cornwall MC, and ASWMC Car Trials championship contenders.
- 5. All competitors must produce appropriate valid club membership cards and must have a current RS Clubman MS UK licence.
- 6. This event is a round of the 2021 ASWMC Car Trials Championship Championship Registration Number TBA
- 7. The programme of the meeting will be as follows:

Signing on and Scrutineering starts at 09:30

The first car will start at 10:30.

Any competitor not signed on by 20 minutes before the time of the first test may be EXCLUDED.

- 8. Public roads will not be used to link sections. There will be at least 6 tests on private land and each competitor will have at least four attempts at each test, according to entry numbers.
  - Details of the tests will be issued at signing on. The entry may be split into groups starting on different sections.
- 9. The event will consist of four classes as follows:
  - 1. All <u>unmodified</u> unballasted standard production front-engined 2wd saloon cars. carrying spare wheel in manufacturers original position (and not having seats or glass removed!) . A sump guard up to 10kg is allowed.

Cars not complying will be reclassified to class 2

- 2. Production modified front-engined 2wd saloon cars
- 3. Production rear—engined rear wheel drive cars.
- 4. Any 2wd car not complying with any of the above classes
- 10. The organisers may need to impose different tyre pressures limits on the day according to conditions and may need to add or merge classes in line with the entries received. There may be different pressures imposed within the classes.
- 11. Entries of vehicles with four wheel drive will not be accepted. All vehicles must comply with the MSA Technical Regulations, and must be fitted with an effective silencer.
- 12. No practising or unnecessary movement of cars will be allowed. Once competitor's front wheels have crossed the start line of an observed section he/she will be deemed to have started the section.
- 13. Competitors will be identified by numbers provided by the organisers.
- 14 Awards will be presented as follows:

1st overall (on index of performance)

1st in each class with at least 3 starters.

2nd in class with at least 6 starters.

Best overall competitor under 16 years of age on day of trial

(No competitor may win more than one award.)

All awards will be presented at the Minehead Motor Club annual dinner

15. The entry list opens on publication of these regulations and closes on Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> October 2021.

The entry fee for the event is £15.

18. The maximum entry for the meeting, including reserves, is 50. The minimum is 6. The maximum for each class is 20 and the minimum is 3. Should any of the above minimum figures not be reached, the organisers have the right to either cancel the meeting or amalgamate classes, as necessary. Entries will be accepted at the discretion of the organisers. Entry fees may be refunded if the entry is withdrawn and notice given in writing (or e-mail) to the secretary of the meeting, at least 24 hours before the event is due to start.

- 20. Provisional results will be circulated by post or email within 7 days of the event. Any protest must be lodged in accordance with Motorsport UK rules (C 5.1 to 5.7.) Results will include all competitors (Minehead members and ASWMC) for class and overall positions
- 21 Marks will be awarded for completion of each section correctly as appropriate. Details of tests, marking and penalties will be issued at drivers briefing..
- All other General Regulations of the MSA apply as written.(see below)

A passenger need not be carried in competing cars. However, if this option is taken up, then a passenger may not be carried throughout the event.

Minimum passenger age is 12, and rear seat passengers must be over two years of age. All passengers under 12 years of age or under 135cm in height must be seated using an approved child restraint. Passengers under 16 years of age will be required to present a letter of consent by a parent or guardian at signing on, to be retained by the organisers. Entries may be accepted from drivers aged 14 or over who do not hold a full RTA licence providing the driver is accompanied by a passenger who holds a full RTA licence and is experienced as a driver in Car or Sporting Trials and must produce a valid club membership card.

Note that in the event of unavoidable postponement of the event all current ASWMC championship contenders will need to unanimously agree to the change of date for the event to still qualify as a championship round.
